On April 1, 2013¹, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) asked that the Commission approve its agreement with the Chariton County Public Water Supply District (“District”). That agreement would allow Missouri-American to sell and deliver water to District. In addition, MAWC filed a related tariff sheet, bearing an effective date of May 1, 2013.

The Commission issued notice on April 2, and AG Processing, Inc. filed a timely application to intervene. No party objected, and the Commission granted AGP intervention by separate order.

The Commission will order Staff to file a Recommendation.


THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
