MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC"), and for its Motion for Expedited Treatment pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. MAWC filed its ISRS petition on June 28, 2021. By an *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge and Rejecting Tariff* ("Order") issued September 15, 2021, the Commission approved ISRS surcharge revenues in the amount of \$7,524,173, and authorized MAWC to file compliance tariff sheets conforming with Staff's calculated ISRS rate.
- 2. The revised ISRS tariff sheet, Tracking No. JW-2022-0056 is attached hereto. Although the tariff bears an effective date 30 days after issuance, MAWC requests that the tariff be allowed to take effect for service rendered on and after October 7, 2021, or as soon thereafter as is reasonable.
- 3. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(14), MAWC submits that the tariff sheets are being filed in compliance with the Commission's *Order*; and, the tariff sheet would implement rates in accordance with Sections 393.1000-1006, RSMo. in regard to plant that has been placed into service between January 1, 2021, and July 31, 2021, and which is currently used and useful and providing service to customers. Therefore, a grant of this Motion would provide rate recognition of this plant at a rate recognized by statute and is

in the public interest. MAWC further states that this Motion is being filed as quickly as possible after the Commission issued its Order.

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully requests an order of the Commission granting this motion and allowing the revised ISRS tariff sheet, Tracking No. JW-2022-0056, to take effect for service rendered on and after October 7, 2021, or as soon thereafter as is reasonable. MAWC requests such additional relief as is necessary or appropriate under the circumstances.

Rate I Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS)

<u>DESCRIPTION</u> - Rate I is designed to recover the costs associated with the Company's eligible main, valve, and hydrant replacements, main relocations, and main cleaning and relining projects. This ISRS rate is calculated and implemented in accordance with the provisions of sections 393.1000 to 393.1006 RSMO. Any future changes to this rate will also be made in accordance with those provisions.

<u>APPLICABILITY</u> - This rate is applicable to any customer class who benefits from the subject utility plant projects eligible for ISRS recovery. The surcharge is calculated consistent with the customer class cost-of-service study recognized by the Missouri Commission in a Company's recent applicable general rate proceeding.

<u>RATE COMPONENTS</u> - In addition to the other charges provided for in the Company's tariffs, a separate charge for the ISRS will apply for service rendered on and after the effective date.

<u>RULES AND REGULATIONS</u> – The General Rules and Regulations set forth in this tariff shall govern the supply of service under this rate.

<u>PAYMENT TERMS</u> - All bills for service under this schedule will be rendered in arrears on a monthly or quarterly basis. The due date on the tariff shall be ten (10) days after the "date of rendition" of the bill to the customer. The customer's bill will be due and payable after this due date. The delinquent date printed on the bill will not be less than twenty-one (21) days after the date of the postmark of the bill. Any accounts remaining unpaid at the expiration of twenty-one (21) days shall be considered delinquent and the Company may take such action as specified in its filed rules and regulations.

<u>TAXES</u> - These rates do not include any municipal, state or federal taxes computed on either billing or consumption basis. Any such taxes applicable shall be added as separate items in rendering each bill.
