## ORDER REQUIRING CATHY J. ORLER TO FILE LATE-FILED EXHIBITS AND DIRECTING RESPONSES TO THOSE EXHIBITS

The Commission held a combined evidentiary hearing in these matters on February 28 through March 2, 2007. During the hearing, Cathy J. Orler offered Exhibit 34 into evidence. Ms. Orler was able to authenticate this document; however, she had added additional markings to the exhibit. The parties all agreed that they would not oppose

admission of this exhibit if Ms. Orler could provide a clean copy of it, and the Commission will direct her to provide said copy.

After the hearing had adjourned, but while all of the parties were still in attendance, Ms. Orler approached the presiding officer requesting to offer her rebuttal testimony from Case No. WA-2006-0480 into evidence. Ms. Orler stated that Commissioner Murray and Commissioner Gaw had requested her to offer this testimony as a late-filed exhibit. Because the parties were all present, the presiding officer convened a conference on this matter and the parties agreed to allow Ms. Orler to offer the testimony subject to confirmation of the request when transcripts become available. Consequently, Ms. Orler will be directed to provide this testimony as a late-filed exhibit, which shall be marked as Exhibit Number 105.

The parties shall be given ten days following the filing of the official transcripts to respond to Ms. Orler's late-filed exhibits. These offerings will be subject to all customary and reasonable objections by the parties and shall not be received into evidence until the presiding officer has ruled on any said objections.

- 1. No later than March 12, 2007, Cathy J. Orler shall file with the Commission the late-filed exhibits as outlined in the body of this order.
- 2. Any party wishing to respond to the late-filed exhibits shall do so no later than tens days following the filing of the official transcripts in these matters.

3. This order shall become effective on March 5, 2007.
