ORDER DIRECTING STAFF REPORT

On June 28, 2006, Mark S. Liesenfeld filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission. Mr. Liesenfeld claims that Mr. Hybl discontinued his water service without notice, and forced him to install a private well. Mr. Hybl failed to timely respond to the complaint.

The Commission believes that a report from the Commission's Staff would help the Commission resolve this matter. Therefore, the Staff shall investigate the allegations in the complaint and report its findings to the Commission, including, but not limited to, whether the Commission has the jurisdiction to award monetary damages.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall investigate the allegations in the complaint and file a written report with the Commission no later than September 11, 2006.

2. Mr. Liesenfeld may respond to the Staff report no later than September 18, 2006.

3. That this order shall become effective on August 11, 2006.
