ORDER DISCONTINUING REPORTING REQUIREMENT

On July 25, 2008, the Commission approved a stipulation and agreement by which the Respondents, Suburban Water and Sewer Company, Inc., and Gordon Burnam, agreed to undertake several actions to improve the service provided to the company's customers. Section A.2 of that stipulation and agreement required Suburban to file monthly reports regarding master meter and customer meter readings for Staff to monitor for any water leakage in the system.

The stipulation and agreement did not establish a date at which Suburban could stop filing those monthly meter-reading reports. However, on February 9, 2009, Staff filed a "Final Report", indicating Suburban had established a meter reading process that enabled the company to monitor and identify water leakage in the system. As a result, Staff concluded Suburban no longer needed to file its monthly reports. At Staff's request, the

Commission closed this file, but did not issue any additional order regarding Suburban's obligation to file monthly reports.

On January 7, 2010, Staff filed a pleading asking the Commission to specifically modify the stipulation and agreement to relieve Suburban of the obligation to file a monthly report. Staff explained it was asking for such an order to clarify the record.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties no more than ten days from the date of filing to respond to any pleading. More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its request and no party has responded to that request.

Staff's request is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant Staff's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Paragraph A.2 of the Stipulation and Agreement between the Staff of the Commission, Suburban Water and Sewer Company, Gordon Burnam, and the Office of the Public Counsel, approved by the Commission on July 25, 2008, is modified to relieve Suburban Water and Sewer Company of the obligation to file a monthly report regarding master meter and customer meter readings.

- 2. This order shall become effective on January 22, 2010
- 3. This file shall be closed on January 23, 2010.
