ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Effective Date: July 1, 2005

This consolidated case concerns the applications filed by various rural electric cooperatives asking the Commission to cancel their certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Staff of the Commission has recommended that those applications be denied. The Commission ordered the parties to consult with each other and to jointly file a proposed procedural schedule. The parties did so and filed a proposed procedural schedule on June 30, 2005.

The proposed procedural schedule establishes a date for the applicants to file a response to Staff's recommendation and for Staff to file a reply. It then recommends a date for a prehearing conference for the purpose of discussing settlement, or for developing a further procedural schedule for the filing of testimony, or a stipulation of facts. If necessary, a hearing could be scheduled at that time.

The Commission finds that the procedural schedule proposed by the parties is reasonable and it will be adopted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following procedural schedule is established:

Applicant's Response to Staff Recommendation	-	July 14, 2005
Staff's Reply	-	July 25, 2005
Prehearing Conference	-	August 9, 2005, beginning at 2:00 p.m.

2. That the prehearing conference will be held in the offices of the Missouri Public Service Commission in Jefferson City, Missouri. This conference will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 3. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
