ORDER CANCELING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

Issue Date: June 21, 2005

Effective Date: July 1, 2005

On June 7, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariff. Staff requested that the Commission cancel Cybertel, Communications Corp.'s interexchange certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff. The Commission granted that certificate to Cybertel in Case No. TA-2001-325.

Staff stated that Cybertel should no longer have its interexchange certificate and tariff because the Missouri Secretary of State revoked Cybertel's authority to conduct business in Missouri for failing to file its annual registration report. Staff stated that it contacted Cybertel, and that Cybertel informed Staff that it is no longer providing telecommunications service in Missouri. Cybertel owes only a minimal amount from its Fiscal Year 2004 assessment.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.081(15) states that parties have 10 days to respond to motions. Cybertel failed to respond to Staff's motion within 10 days.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel Cybertel's interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariff is granted.
2. That the interexchange telecommunications certificate of service authority granted to Cybertel, Communications Corp. in Case No. TA-2001-325, is canceled.
3. That the accompanying interexchange tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1, is canceled.
4. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
5. That this case may be closed on July 2, 2005.
