ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF

Issue Date: April 24, 2007 Effective Date: May 4, 2007

On April 2, 2007, Intercounty Tele-Tech L.L.C. filed an application to cancel its certificates of service authority and the accompanying tariff. Applicant states that it does not provide service to end-users and that no customer will be harmed by the Commission granting this application.

On April 20, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed its memorandum recommending that the Commission cancel the company's certificate. Staff informs the Commission that the company was granted a certificate of service authority, in Case No. TA-99-175, to provide interexchange and non-switched local telephone service. The company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, was also approved. Staff further states that the company is not delinquent in filing any annual report or paying any PSC assessment.

Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed the company's application and Staff's recommendation and finds that approving the

application is reasonable. The Commission will therefore cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Intercounty Tele-Tech, L.C.C in Case No. TA-99-175.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications service granted to Intercounty Tele-Tech, L.L.C., in Case No. TA-99-175, is canceled.
- 2. Intercounty Tele-Tech, L.L.C.'s accompanying tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 is also canceled.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on May 4, 2007.
 - 4. This case shall be closed on May 5, 2007.
