ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: July 5, 2012

Effective Date: August 5, 2012

On June 21, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Yak Communications (America), Inc. ("Yak") certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number XA-2004-0104, the Commission granted Yak a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, was also approved.

Staff states in its motion that Yak requested the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority. Yak is not deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report and is current on the payment of fiscal year assessments. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

On June 22, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than July 2, 2012. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Yak Communications (America), Inc., shall be canceled. Although Staff did not request the cancellation of the accompanying tariff, Yak cannot provide service without a certificate. Therefore Commission will also cancel Yak’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services granted to Yak Communications (America), Inc., in File Number XA-2004-0104, is canceled.
2. Yak Communications (America), Inc.’s tariff, P.S.C. Mo No. 1, is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on August 5, 2012.

4. This case may be closed on August 6, 2012.
