ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On April 18, 2016, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Angel Americas, LLC's ("Angel Americas") certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-2014-0083, the Commission granted Angel Americas a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that on December 24, 2015, Angel Americas contacted Staff stating Angel Americas was no longer providing service in Missouri and requesting the Commission cancel Angel Americas' certificate of service authority. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services.

On April 20, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties until May 2, 2016, to file an objection or request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Angel Americas, LLC, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Angel Americas, LLC, in File Number TA-2014-0083, is canceled.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on May 23, 2016.
 - This case may be closed on May 24, 2016.
