## STATUS REPORT

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and on behalf of Staff and Davidson Telecom, LLC ("Davidson" or "Company"), files this *Status Report* and states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. On November 8, 2012,<sup>1</sup> Staff filed motions to cancel Davidson's certificates of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange, nonswitched local exchange and basic local telecommunications services for the Company's failure to submit annual reports and MoUSF net jurisdictional revenue reports, and remit MoUSF assessments.
- 2. On November 19, Davidson objected to Staff's motions and requested the Commission set a procedural schedule and evidentiary hearing for each matter. On November 20, the Commission issued its *Order Setting Prehearing Conference* directing a prehearing conference on December 11.

- 3. On December 11, the Commission convened a prehearing conference. At the prehearing conference, Regulatory Law Judge Stearley directed the parties to file a status report by January 2, 2013. This filing complies with that directive.
- 4. The parties are engaged in discussions toward settlement of all issues and request until February 4, 2013, to provide notice to the Commission of settlement, file a status report on the progress of settlement or file a proposed procedural schedule should settlement fail.

WHEREFORE, Staff files this *Status Report* on behalf of Staff and Davidson Telecom, LLC, and requests the Commission allow the parties until February 4, 2013, to provide notice to the Commission of settlement, file a status report on the progress of settlement or file a proposed procedural schedule should settlement fail.
