## MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to cancel the certificate of service authority and associated tariff of AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., d/b/a ConQuest ("ConQuest"). For its Motion, Staff states as follows:

- 1. On October 31, 2006, the Commission granted ConQuest a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri and approved the associated tariff in Case No. TA-2007-0136.
- 2. On February 27, 2013, Staff received ConQuest's Statement of Revenue for calendar year 2012. (See Highly Confidential Attachment A). ConQuest indicated on the form that it no longer wished to retain its certificate of service authority.
- 3. Because ConQuest requested cancellation of its certificate and is not providing services in Missouri to the best of Staff's knowledge, information and belief, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate.
- 4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2012), which provides "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice

and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

- 5. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D., 1989).
- 6. ConQuest is current on the payment of fiscal year assessments, but has not submitted its 2012 calendar year annual report.
- 7. Staff is not aware of any other matter that the Commission's decision in this case will affect, or be affected by.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority and associated tariff of AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., d/b/a ConQuest to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
