ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

Issue Date: January 26, 2017

Effective Date: February 5, 2017

Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc. ("Gold Line") filed a letter with the Commission stating it no longer wished to retain its certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide telecommunications services in the State of Missouri.

In File Number TA-2002-291, the Commission granted Gold Line a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications services in the State of Missouri, and approved its tariff. Specifically Gold Line was approved to provide interexchange telecommunications services. The Company's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1 was also approved.

On January 12, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to File a Recommendation. On January 18, 2017, Staff filed their recommendation and stated that Gold Line has no plans to re-enter the market and does not serve any customers or have active operations in the State of Missouri. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications services and the company's accompanying tariff.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Gold Line’s request and Staff’s recommendation, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc., shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services granted to Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc., in File Number TA-2002-291, is canceled.
2. Gold Line Telemanagement, Inc.’s tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1 is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on February 5, 2017.
4. This case may be closed on February 6, 2017.


