## ORDER GRANTING WAIVERS

Issue Date: December 21, 2010 Effective Date: December 29, 2010

On August 28, 2008, House Bill 1779 became effective, modifying §392.420, RSMo 2000 (Supp. 2009), so that it now provides, in pertinent part:

The commission is authorized, in connection with ... a certificate of interexchange ... service authority ... to entertain a petition to suspend or modify the application of its rules or the application of any statutory provision contained in sections 392.200 to 392.340 if such waiver or modification is otherwise consistent with the other provisions of sections 392.361 to 392.520 and the purposes of this chapter.

On November 29, 2010, Zone Telecom, Inc. ("Zone") filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") that the Commission waive certain rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo (Supp 2009). Zone also submitted a tariff filing to identify these waivers. That tariff filing has been assigned Tariff File No. YX-2011-0269 and bears a proposed effective date of December 29, 2010.

On December 15, 2010, the Commission Staff submitted its memorandum concerning the request. It noted that:

- 1. The company is an interexchange telecommunications company as that term is used in Section 392.420.
- 2. The company is currently compliant in obligations relating to Commission assessment, Missouri Universal Service Fund, Relay Missouri, and the submission of an annual report.

The waivers requested by the Company are:

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392.210.2 Accounting (system of accounts)
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The Staff recommends that the Commission grant the requested waivers and either approve or allow the tariff listing these waivers to take effect by operation of law.

Based on the requirements of Section 392.420 and 392.245.5(8) and the verified application and Staff recommendation, the Commission finds that the waivers are consistent with the provisions and purposes of Chapter 392, RSMo. Therefore, the
