ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On December 17, 2020, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion requesting that the Commission cancel the certificate of interexchange service authority of Legacy Long Distance International, Inc. (Company). On January 5, 2000, the Commission granted the Company a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange service in Case No. TA-2000-342.¹ The Staff's motion states that the Company wishes to voluntarily relinquish its authority. The Company does not have an applicable tariff.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.² Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
