## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

Issue Date: June 22, 2015

Effective Date: July 2, 2015

On June 15, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Globalinx Enterprises, Inc.'s ("Globalinx") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. On June 22, 2015, Staff filed an Amended Motion to Cancel Certificate of Service Authority and Tariff to include the cancellation Globalinx's Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (IVoIP) Registration. The Commission granted Globalinx a Registration to provide IVoIP service in the State of Missouri in File Number DA-2013-0387.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's amended motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's amended motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**


1. Anyone wishing to respond to Staff's Amended Motion or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than July 2, 2015, with:
