STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On January 13, 2009, First Choice Technology, ("First Choice") and NetLojix Telecom, Inc. ("NetLojix") (collectively "Applicants") asked the Commission, pursuant to Section 392.300 RSMo 2000, and 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 3.535, to grant them the authority necessary to consummate transactions involving the transfer of NetLojix's Missouri residential and business long distance customer accounts to First Choice. NetLojix does not have any customers in the state of Missouri. Thereby, First Choice is not submitting any tariffs with this request.
- 2. Applicable case law provides that the Commission may "not withhold its approval of the disposition of assets unless it can be shown that such disposition is detrimental to the public interest." *State ex rel. Fee Fee Trunk Sewer, Inc. v. Litz,* 596 S.W. 2d 466, 468 (Mo. App. E.D. 1980), citing to *State ex rel. City of St. Louis v. Public Serv. Comm'n of Mo.*, 73 S.W. 2d 392, 400 (Mo. banc 1934).
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff states its opinion that the transfer is not detrimental to the public interest and recommends approval of the transfer and tariff sheets.

4. NetLojix requested, and Staff recommends that the Commission cancel NetLojix's certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications and its tariffs.

5. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2007), which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected." The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing." State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (1989).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission approve the proposed transfer and cancel NetLojix's certificate and tariff.
