STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), and for its Recommendation respectfully states as follows:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum (Appendix A), the Staff recommends that the Commission recognize the use of the fictitious name "FairPoint Communications" by ExOp of Missouri, Inc. ("ExOp").
- 2. ExOp has fulfilled the requirements of the Commission's rule governing name changes at 4 CSR 240-2.060(5) in that the request contains a clear statement of the old and new names, and the request was accompanied by (a) a copy of the Registration of Fictitious Name issued by the Missouri Secretary of State (demonstrating that ExOp of Missouri, Inc. has registered the name FairPoint Communications for use in Missouri); and (b) an adoption notice and a revised tariff title page identifying the new name on the ExOp's interexchange/non-switched local exchange tariff.
- 3. Customers have been notified of the name change in compliance with 4 CSR 240-3.545(20).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an Order acknowledging that ExOp of Missouri, Inc. will do business under the fictitious name of FairPoint Communications, and approving the tariff sheets filed to effectuate that name change, effective February 27, 2008, as requested by ExOp.
