**ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER**

On April 18, 2005, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel filed a Motion for Protective Order. In their motion, CenturyTel and Spectra indicate that a protective order is necessary to facilitate the exchange of highly confidential and proprietary information. They request that the Commission issue its standard protective order to establish the manner in which such information should be handled.

Upon review of the motion, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and that the request for a protective order is reasonable.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion for Protective Order filed by CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel is granted and the protective order attached to this order (Attachment A) is adopted.

2. That this order shall become effective on April 20, 2005.
