STAFF RESPONSE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), through the undersigned counsel, and hereby respectfully submits this Staff Response.

- 1. On May 29, 2012, the above-reference company sent a letter to the Secretary of the Commission advising it that it had changed its name. Contrary to the File No. designation, Telrite Corporation ("the Company) is not an interexchange telecommunications company certificated by the Commission, but is a wireless carrier not regulated by the Commission (it should be an "R" matter, not an "X"). As such, the Company has no certificate with the Commission and no name on a certificate that can be changed.
- 2. Wireless carriers may be designated as Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) pursuant to federal law by the Commission for the sole purpose of providing wireless Lifeline service to low income customers.
- 3. The informational mailing that was mistakenly docketed as this case has been routed internally to the Staff member who tracks the ETCs for the Commission and the Universal Service Board so that the Commissions, the USB's and the Missouri Universal Service Fund Administrator can update their records. Accordingly, this matter may be closed without further action.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that Commission close this matter without further action.
