ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: July 22, 2015

Effective Date: August 1, 2015

Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) filed the tariff.¹ The tariff proposes to change the rates for KCP&L’s Demand-Side Investment Mechanism as follows.

<i>Class</i>	<i>Current Rate</i>	<i>Proposed Rate</i>	<i>Amount²</i>
Residential	\$0.00352	\$0.00132	- \$2.20
Non-Residential	\$0.00247	\$0.00450	+ \$2.03

Because the tariff proposes to increase a rate, KCP&L has the burden of proving that propriety of the tariff.³

The Commission received no application for intervention and no notice of intent to participate within the time prescribed by regulation.⁴ The Commission’s staff (“Staff”) filed a recommendation supporting the tariff.⁵ The Commission received no response to the

recommendation within the time set by Commission regulation.⁶ Based on the verified filings, the Commission independently concludes that the tariff supports safe and adequate service at just and reasonable rates, so the Commission will approve the tariff.

The absence of opposition to the tariff supports an effective date less than 30 days from the issuance of this order.⁷

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff to which the Commission assigned tracking no. JE-2015-0349 is approved. The specific tariff approved is:

2nd Revised Sheet No. 49E, Replacing 1st Revised Sheet No. 49E.

2. This order shall become effective on August 1, 2015.
