**CORRECTED ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF FILING**

Effective Date: June 4, 2015

This notice corrects the order issued on June 3.<sup>1</sup> Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) filed a tariff to adjust its Demand Side Investment Mechanism Rider (“DSIM”).<sup>2</sup> The tariff bears a proposed effective date of August 1.

The Commission’s regulations provide that any party to the action in which the Commission approved the DSIM is a party to this action, and may file a notice of intention to participate, so the Commission will direct the addition of those persons to the service list for this action, and will also direct notice as set forth below.

The Commission’s regulations also provide that Staff shall file a recommendation no later than 30 days after the filing of the tariff,<sup>3</sup> which will be July 1. The Commission’s regulations further provide that any notice of intent to participate<sup>4</sup> and any application for intervention<sup>5</sup> is due 30 days after the issuance of this notice. Adjusting for a State holiday and weekend,<sup>6</sup> that date will be July 6.
