- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome everyone. We are
- 3 here for the pre-hearing conference in Case No.
- 4 XM-2008-0291 which concerns the application of PNG
- 5 Telecommunications, Inc., to acquire certain assets of
- 6 GlobalTouch Telecom, Inc.
- We'll begin today by taking entries of appearance
- 8 starting with PNG Telecommunications.
- 9 MS. YOUNG: Thank you, Judge. Please let
- 10 the record reflect the appearance of Mary Ann Young
- 11 with William D. Steinmeier, P.C.
- 12 I provided the court reporter with a written
- 13 appearance with our address and other contact
- 14 information.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for staff?
- MR. HAAS: Good morning. William K. Haas
- 17 appearing on behalf of the staff of the Public Service
- 18 Commission. My address is Post Office Box 360,
- 19 Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And I don't see anyone
- 21 here for the Office of Public Counsel which would be
- 22 the only other party.
- The Commission scheduled this pre-hearing
- 24 conference at the request of staff, and my
- 25 understanding is staff is looking for some additional

- 1 information from the company.
- 2 Mr. Haas, can you explain what the situation is?
- 3 MR. HAAS: One of the pieces of information
- 4 that we are looking for is documentation that the
- 5 tariff filing, which the company just made in the last
- 6 couple of days, to grandfather the services being
- 7 provided to the acquired customers, were the same rate
- 8 plans that were being provided to the customers by
- 9 their previous provider.
- 10 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And once you have that
- 11 information you'll be able to do a recommendation to
- 12 the Commission?
- MR. HAAS: I hope so.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Ms. Young, what's the
- 15 situation from the company's perspective?
- 16 MS. YOUNG: I had just a few preliminary
- 17 matters, Judge, and one of them was to mention that
- 18 the tariff has been filed. It has been assigned
- 19 Tariff File No. JX-2008-0637. It was filed on
- 20 April 27th with a proposed effective date of June 1st.
- 21 I intend to file a supplement to the application
- 22 and submit a copy of that tariff so that it will be
- 23 reflected in the case file for this matter. We also
- 24 received additional data requests from staff yesterday
- and will be working to respond to those.

- 1 I think, in light of the timing of the tariff
- 2 filing, and the fact we do still have some discovery
- 3 from staff, PNG acknowledges that the April 30th
- 4 request for action by the Commission is highly
- 5 unlikely at this point. But we do hope that we can
- 6 resolve any outstanding information requests from the
- 7 staff so that we can get the matter to the Commission
- 8 for consideration very soon.
- 9 And I don't know that we need to modify the motion
- 10 for expedited treatment, other than what we say today
- 11 on the record, but we certainly would hope to get the
- 12 matter wrapped up as soon as possible, and possibly
- 13 even -- if we could work things out with staff -- ask
- 14 for the tariff to go into effect sooner than June 1st
- 15 if that's possible.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Well, it doesn't sound
- 17 like we're going to need a procedural schedule, as far
- 18 as a hearing or anything at this point, so the purpose
- 19 of really today is for the parties to get together and
- 20 discuss what is needed and what can be given to staff,
- 21 so I don't really need to be here for that part of the
- 22 discussion.
- 23 I'll just wait then for -- I guess I'm waiting for
- 24 staff to file a recommendation or any other motion
- 25 that you need to file as far as if you don't get what

you need.

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          I will ask that if nothing else has happened
     within a week from today that you give me a status
     report. And, of course, if you can get the work done
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     and get the recommendation filed before then, then
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     don't worry about the status report.
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          Any questions or any matters anyone else wants to
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     bring up?
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          All right. With that then, the on-the-record
     portion of the proceeding is adjourned. I'll leave
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     you to your discussions, and good luck.
