**NOTICE REGARDING NAME CHANGE**  
**AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: January 9, 2006

Effective Date: February 4, 2006

On December 23, 2005, MCI Communications Services, Inc. filed proposed tariff sheets adding the fictitious name, Verizon Business Services. The tariff sheets bore an effective date of January 23, 2006. Upon Staff filing its Memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheets, the Commission issued an order on January 3, 2006, recognizing the company's name change and approving the tariff sheets.

Realizing that it omitted tariff sheets from its initial filing, MCI filed additional tariff sheets, Tariff File No. JX-2006-0523. On January 5, 2005, Staff filed a Memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the additional tariff pages.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(5) states that a name change can be accomplished by filing a statement, clearly setting out the old and new name, evidence of registration with the Missouri Secretary of State, and an adoption notice and revised tariff title sheets with an effective date of no fewer than 30 days.

Having already issued an order recognizing the company's name change, the Commission finds that the additional revised tariff sheets, reflecting the name change, will be approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the revised tariff sheets, Tariff File No. JX-2006-0523, are approved to become effective on February 4, 2006.

2. That the following tariff pages are approved:

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**1<sup>st</sup> Revised Adoption Notice, Replaces Original Adoption Notice  
2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Title Page, Cancels Revised Title Page**

3. That this order shall become effective on February 4, 2006.

4. That this case may be closed on February 5, 2006.
