ORDER DISMISSING AND CLOSING CASE

Telrite Corporation ("Company") was granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") effective on December 8, 2003. On November 10, 2010, the Company was also granted designation by the Commission as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for the purpose of receiving federal universal service fund support for wireless Lifeline service to low income customers. On May 29, 2012, the Company sent a letter to the Commission advising it that the Company had registered a fictitious name with the Missouri Secretary of State and would be offering services in the State of Missouri under the name of Life Wireless. On May 31, 2012, the Commission directed its Staff to file a recommendation relating to the name change, which was subsequently filed on June 6, 2012.

Staff asserts in its response and in a motion filed in a related case, File No. XO-2011-0062, that although the Company offers wireless Lifeline service under the name "Life Wireless", this name does not apply to its interexchange service. Wireless carriers are not regulated by the Commission, so the Company has no certificate with the Commission to provide wireless service. Consequently, there is no name on a certificate relating to wireless service that can be changed. Staff further

states that the Company's letter was mistakenly docketed as this File Number, appropriate Commission records have already been updated accordingly to reflect the new fictitious name, and this matter should be closed without further action. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. No party has responded to Staff's pleading within the ten day time period. Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(4), the Commission will dismiss this matter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This case is dismissed and closed.
2. This order shall become effective on July 1, 2012.
