On September 2, 2010, Telrite Corporation filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support for wireless service. Telrite explains that it seeks such status solely for the purpose of providing the service supported by, and participating in, the Low Income Programs of the Universal Service Fund. It does not request ETC status for the purpose of participating in any High Cost Programs of the Fund.

Notice of Telrite’s application shall be sent to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide services in Missouri, Additionally, the Commission will set a date by which requests to intervene shall be filed.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send notice of this application to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide service in Missouri.
2. Requests to intervene shall be filed with the Commission no later than September 29, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
