ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a pending tariff on November 21,

2017. Staff's recommendation is due no later than 30 days from that date¹ and the Commission will set a date for filing any reply to the recommendation. ² Parties to the general rate case in which the Commission approved the fuel adjustment clause are parties to this case without having to file an application for intervention.³ The Commission will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. For anyone else, the Commission will set a deadline for filing an application to intervene.⁴ The tariff bears a proposed effective date of January 25, 2018.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than December 4, 2017.
- 2. Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than December 22, 2017.
- 3. Any response to the recommendation is due on December 29, 2017.
