ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: February 22, 2018

On January 30, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed tariffs that would implement a general rate increase for electric service. The Commission received timely intervention requests from: The Missouri Division of Energy; Midwest Energy Consumers Group; Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri; and Dogwood Energy, LLC.¹

At a prehearing conference held on February 21, 2018, counsel for KCP&L and GMO stated that the companies do not oppose the intervention requests. Thus, the Commission will take the applications for intervention up unopposed.

¹ Dogwood applied to intervene only in File No. ER-2018-0146. All other applicants asked to intervene in both File Nos. ER-2018-0145 and ER-2018-0146.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications, the Commission finds that the applicants meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene filed by: The Missouri Division of Energy; Midwest Energy Consumers Group; Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri; and Dogwood Energy, LLC are granted.
2. Dogwood Energy, LLC is an intervenor in File No. ER-2018-0146 only.
3. The Missouri Division of Energy; Midwest Energy Consumers Group; Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri are intervenors in both File No. ER-2018-0145 and ER-2018-0146.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
