On February 5, 2020, some of the parties met at a discovery conference to discuss certain discovery disputes. During the conference, the parties agreed to meet again to discuss the discovery dispute that the Sierra Club set out in its Statement of Discovery Disagreement or Concern filed on February 4, 2020. The parties may also discuss the unresolved portion of the Statement of Discovery Disagreement or Concern filed by the Sierra Club on January 31, 2020. Therefore, the Commission will set an additional discovery conference.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. A discovery conference will be held on February 10, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
2. Any party may attend a discovery conference, but only Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and the Sierra Club are required to attend.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
