ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE TRUE-UP

Issue Date: February 10, 2016 Effective Date: March 1, 2016

On December 30, 2015, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed an application for its fourteenth Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC") true-up filing. The filing identifies the under-recovery of GMO's FAC for the 12 months in Recovery Period 14 (September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015). GMO operates in two rate districts, "MPS" and "L&P." During Recovery Period 14, GMO states that it under-recovered \$867,009 from customers in its MPS rate district, and under-recovered \$138,762 from customers in its L&P rate district.

The under-recovered amounts for the MPS and L&P rate districts, including accumulated interest, are included in GMO's calculation of its proposed Fuel Adjustment Rates in the FAC adjustment filing currently before the Commission in File No. ER-2016-0165. On January 29, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation on GMO's true-up filing, as required by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D). Based on its examination and analysis of information filed by GMO, including the direct testimony of Linda Nunn, and supporting schedules, Staff recommends the Commission approve GMO's true-up filing amounts for Recovery Period 14.

Based on the direct testimony of Linda Nunn and the uncontested recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve GMO's true-up filing. The Commission will allow this order to go into effect in less than thirty days so that it may coincide with the Commission's order in File No. ER-2016-0165.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company's true-up filing for the fourteenth recovery period (September 1, 2014 through August 31, 2015) is approved.
 - 2. This order shall be effective on March 1, 2016.
 - 3. This file shall be closed on March 2, 2016.
