ORDER REOPENING CASE AND CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF

On February 17, 2005, the Commission approved Telrite Corporation's request to buy OneStar Long Distance, Inc.'s assets and customer base. In that order, the Commission ordered Telrite to file tariffs before serving OneStar's former customers. The Commission approved Telrite's tariffs on June 5, and closed the case on June 6.

On June 17, the Staff of the Commission filed its Motion to Reopen Case and Cancel the Certificate and Tariff of OneStar Long Distance, Inc. Staff stated that on June 17, counsel for OneStar and Telrite advised Staff that the transfer of assets from OneStar to Telrite was complete. Counsel for OneStar and Telrite also informed Staff that OneStar's certificate of service authority and tariff could be canceled. As such, Staff asks the Commission to reopen the case to cancel OneStar's certificate and tariff.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. OneStar has not responded to Staff's motion.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, finds it reasonable, and will grant

it.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Reopen Case and Cancel the

Certificate and Tariff of OneStar Long Distance, Inc., is granted.

2. That the interexchange certificate of service authority the Commission granted OneStar Long Distance, Inc., in Case No. TA-98-50, is canceled.

3. That OneStar Long Distance, Inc's., tariff, Missouri PSC Tariff. No. 2, Tariff

No. JX-2002-0197, is hereby canceled.

- 4. That this order shall become effective on July 22, 2005.
- 5. That this case may be closed on July 23, 2005.
