ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT TRUE-UP AND APPROVING TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES

Effective Date: September 1, 2017

In each of these files, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed a tariff and supporting testimony. Staff filed a recommendation in favor of the tariff. The Commission received no application for intervention.

The Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”) commented that it believed GMO’s filing is deficient regarding the reporting of off-systems sales. However, OPC did not raise its concern to GMO within the ten days of the tariff filing as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161. As a result, OPC states that it does not object to GMO’s filing.

In File No. ER-2017-0359, GMO seeks the Commission's approval of true-up amounts related to the company's fuel adjustment clause ("FAC").¹ Specifically, the amounts relate to the company's Recovery Period 17.² For that period, GMO alleges a true-up amount of \$57,081 in over-recovery and \$489,986 in accrued interest. Those amounts are components of the FAC for Accumulation Period 20, which is the subject of File No. ER-2017-0357.³ In that case, GMO asks to increase its rates per kilowatt hour ("kWh") by \$0.00225. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month, the tariff increases the FAC by approximately \$2.31 per month.

On the basis of the verified and uncontested filings, the Commission concludes that the tariff conforms to the applicable statutes, regulations, and tariffs. Thus, the Commission will approve the tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The tariff assigned Tracking No. JE-2017-0280 is approved to become effective on September 1, 2017.
2. The specific tariff sheet approved is:

1st Revised Sheet No. 127.12, Canceling Original Sheet No. 127.12
3. This order shall be effective on September 1, 2017.

¹ An FAC passes increases or decreases in net fuel cost to customers without a general rate case.

² Recovery Period 17 is March 1, 2016 through February 28, 2017.

³ Accumulation Period 20 is December 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017.

4. This file shall close on September 2, 2017.
