PUBLIC COUNSEL'S WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO COMPEL

The Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) asks that the Commission treat its earlier filed Motion to Compel as withdrawn as follows:

1. The OPC filed a Motion to Compel on February 10, 2020, regarding an ongoing disagreement on the scope of discovery. Since that filing, the OPC, Union Electric d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and other parties have had productive settlement discussions. There is now a revenue requirement agreement in principle.
2. Considering the progress of settlement discussion, the OPC believes that its discovery dispute need not be addressed by the Public Service Commission at this time.
3. In withdrawing its Motion to Compel, the OPC is not rescinding any previous position or argument.

WHEREFORE, the OPC withdraws its Motion to Compel.
