On December 6, 2019, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) submitted its suggested customer notice for local public hearings in The Empire District Electric Company's (Empire) pending rate proceeding. On December 11, 2019, the Commission issued an order setting local public hearings, but reserved ruling on the customer notice. On December 16, 2019, Empire filed a response to OPC's suggested customer notice offering an alternative customer notice, and on December 20, 2019, the Commission's Staff filed a response in support of Empire's position.

The Commission has considered the customer notices and has determined that Empire's customer notice is the least confusing, but that a row should be added to include a chart showing the residential class average annual impact.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Customer notice attached to this order as Attachment A is approved by the Commission and shall be provided to each of The Empire District Electric Company's customers.
