ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

The Commission opened this case on February 21, 2018 to consider the propriety of the electric rates charged by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri in light of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017. The Commission directed that applications to intervene be filed by March 5. The Consumers Council of Missouri applied to intervene on March 21. More than ten days have passed, and no party has opposed that application

The Commission finds that allowing Consumers Council to intervene will serve the public interest. Further, the Commission finds that Consumers Council has shown good cause for its late request to intervene. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3) and (10), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Consumers Council of Missouri’s Application to Intervene is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
