**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE**

The Commission opened this case on February 21, 2018 to consider the propriety of the electric rates charged by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri in light of the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC), the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG), and Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed timely applications to intervene. The Commission ordered that any party wishing to respond to those applications do so by March 9. No such response has been filed.

The Commission finds that allowing MIEC, MECG, and Renew Missouri to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers’ Application to Intervene is granted.
2. The Midwest Energy Consumers Group’s Application to Intervene is granted.
3. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri’s Application to Intervene is granted.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
