# ORDER SCHEDULING ORAL ARGUMENT REGARDING THE ISSUANCE OF ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY ORDERS TO ADDRESS THE EFFECT OF FEDERAL TAX CUTS

Issue Date: April 18, 2018

Effective Date: April 18, 2018

The Commission opened these rate cases to address concerns that the specified electric, gas, and steam utilities' existing rate schedules may no longer be just and reasonable in light of the recently enacted Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, which reduced the federal corporate income tax rate from 35 percent to 21 percent.

The Commission ordered each of the utilities to show cause why the Commission should not order them to promptly file tariffs to reduce their rates for every class and category of service to reflect the percentage reduction in its federal-state effective income tax rate. Each utility responded by arguing that the Commission could require them to adjust their rates only as part of a general rate case in which all relevant factors are considered rather than through isolated consideration of the single issue of income tax rates.

The Commission will schedule an oral argument to address the question of whether the Commission should issue an accounting authority order in each of these cases to preserve any excess revenues resulting from the income tax rate changes for possible adjustment in these or future rate cases.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Oral argument regarding the issuance of accounting authority orders is scheduled for May 24, 2018, beginning at 10:00 a.m.<sup>1</sup> The argument will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you need additional accommodations to participate in
