**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

Issue Date: January 11, 2017

Effective Date: January 26, 2017

On November 22, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a tariff and supporting testimony to revise its Energy Efficiency Investment Charge (EEIC) Rider. The tariff bears an effective date of January 26, 2017.

The EEIC Rider filing would increase annual rates by approximately \$44.1 million. Such an increase would result in a 2.8 percent increase in a typical residential customer's bill, which is an increase of approximately \$3.03 per month. Ameren Missouri filed this tariff to recover the cost of its Cycle 2 Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) programs, which will run from March 1, 2016, through February 28, 2019.

On December 22, 2016, as required by Commission rule<sup>1</sup>, the Staff of the Commission filed a Recommendation. Staff agrees with Ameren Missouri's analysis, and recommends that the Commission approve the tariff.

Based on the direct testimony of William Davis, provided by Ameren Missouri, and the recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve the tariff.
