**NOTICE REGARDING FUEL ADJUSTMENT TRUE-UP
AND TARIFF TO CHANGE FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE RATES**

On July 27, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed the above-referenced applications and tariff.¹ The Staff of the Commission filed a favorable recommendation on August 28. Staff noted that the tariff would decrease the Fuel Adjustment Charge of an Ameren Missouri residential customer's bill by \$0.96 per month. No party objected to the application and tariff.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(4) states:

If the FAC rate adjustment is in accordance with the provisions of this rule, section 386.266, RSMo, and the FAC mechanism established in the most recent general rate proceeding, the commission shall either issue an interim rate adjustment order approving the tariff schedules and the FAC rate adjustments within sixty (60) days of the electric utility's filing or, if no such order is issued, the tariff schedules and the FAC rate adjustments shall take effect sixty (60) days after the tariff schedules were filed.

Because the Commission finds that the FAC adjustment complies with the above-referenced rule and statute, the Commission gives notice that it will allow the tariff schedules and FAC rate adjustments to take effect on September 25, 2017, 60 days after the tariff schedules were filed.
