NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND ORDER SETTING TIME FOR FILINGS

Issue Date: September 28, 2017

Effective Date: September 28, 2017

The Empire District Electric Company filed the pending tariff on September 27, 2017. Staff's recommendation is due no later than 30 days from that date.¹ The Commission will set a date for filing a response to the recommendation.² Parties to the general rate case in which the Commission approved the fuel adjustment clause are parties to this case without having to file an application for intervention.³ The Commission will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. For anyone else, the Commission will set a deadline for filing an application to intervene.⁴ The tariff bears a proposed effective date of December 1, 2017.



THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any application for intervention shall be filed no later than October 18, 2017.
2. Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than October 27, 2017.
3. Any response to the recommendation is due on November 6, 2017.
4. The Commission's Data Center shall add to the service list all parties to the action in File No. ER-2016-0023.
5. The Commission's Data Center shall send this notice and order to all parties to the action in File No. ER-2016-0023.
6. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make this notice and order available to all members of the General Assembly serving persons within the service territories at issue, and to the news media serving the service territories at issue.
7. This order shall be effective when issued.
