### **Ameren Missouri Operations Filing**

On April 20, 2022, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), filed with the Commission one (1) tariff sheet<sup>1</sup> bearing an issue date of April 20, 2022 and an effective date of May 20, 2022, proposing to extend the Voluntary Green/Pure Power pilot program through December 31, 2024. Pilot Program customers that choose to transition will be given priority for Rider CSP enrollment or on any waitlist and will be considered to have been enrolled in Rider CSP from the date of their pilot Program enrollment.

Ameren Missouri stated that the revision listed above was consistent with the stipulation and agreement approved in its 2019 rate case, ER-2019-0335. The Commission issued its Order Directing Staff Recommendation on April 28, 2022, which directed Staff to file its recommendation no later than May 2, 2022, at 11:00 a.m.
