RECONCILIATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and respectfully submits the accompanying Reconciliation of the issues reserved for hearing in this matter pursuant to the procedural schedule ordered for this case, and respectfully states as follows:

1. As stated in the Reconciliation, the valuations were provided to Staff by OPC and Sierra Club as ordered in the procedural schedule. Therefore, inclusion of these valuations by Staff in this Reconciliation should not be deemed as agreement by Staff or any other party of the appropriateness of these valuations.

2. The issues reflected on the Reconciliation have no revenue requirement impact in this case. The revenue requirement impact, if any, will be deferred by Ameren Missouri and be reflected in revenue requirement in Ameren Missouri's next general rate proceeding.

3. The attached Reconciliation is based on the agreement in principle which has been reached among the parties and which will be reflected in a Stipulation and Agreement which will hopefully soon be filed in this case. Therefore the Reconciliation may be somewhat different than others with which the Commission is familiar.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission accept the accompanying Reconciliation.
