APPLICATION OF SBC ADVANCED SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY

COMES NOW SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. ("ASI") and hereby applies for approval by

the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the accompanying Interconnection

Agreement voluntarily entered into by ASI and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT"),

pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act ("Act") under 47 U.S.C. § 252(a)(1) and (i). This

agreement covers the provision of interconnection, service and network elements.

1. ASI is a wholly-owned subsidiary of SBC Communications, Inc. The legal name and

ASI respectfully requests that the Interconnection Agreement become effective following the filing of this notice with the Commission, or as soon thereafter as practicable.

In support of this Application, ASI states the following:

I. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

ASI presents to this Commission for approval, an Agreement that was negotiated and executed pursuant to the terms of the Act. Following good faith negotiations to address all of the complex issues involved in such an agreement, the parties signed the Interconnection Agreement between SWBT and ASI on September 3, 1999 and September 1, 1999, respectively, and hereby file the Agreement, together with the twenty-four (24) appendices incorporated therein. There are no outstanding issues between SWBT and ASI that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

ASI seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Act. ASI believes that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity, and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes interconnectivity and diversity in providers, and will increase customer choices for telecommunications services after ASI is certified and has effective tariffs.

ASI respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This is a bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiation and compromise between ASI and SWBT.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Act with provides:

- (e) APPROVAL BY STATE COMMISSION
 - (1) APPROVAL REQUIRED. Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
- (2) GROUNDS FOR REJECTION. The State Commission may only reject -
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity;

IV. MISSOURI LEGISLATION

The negotiated and executed Agreement is consistent with Missouri Senate Bill 507, which became effective on August 28, 1996. After certification and the approval of its tariffs, ASI will be allowed to provide the customer with increased choices.

WHEREFORE, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. respectfully requests the Commission to enter an Order approving its Interconnection Agreement.
