In accordance with the Commission's Order Regarding Union Electric Company's Tree-Trimming Policies and Closing Case, issued March 31, 2005, AmerenUE filed its Missouri Vegetation Management O&M Budget, Missouri Overhead System Feeder Master File, Budget Dollar Amounts for Transmission & Distribution for the Next Year and Actual Dollar Amounts for Transmission & Distribution for 2006.

Because of operational conflicts, the financials, normally contained in document "mpsc2007" at Tab1, Sheet 14, were not available on February 15th. That information is now available and is attached to this letter.

Attached is the following file:

Tab1Sheet14mpsc2007.xls - The 2006 O&M expenditures and the 2007 O&M Budgets are provided by operating center. In addition the spreadsheet shows the total distribution miles completed under Performance Management for 2004, 2005, 2006, and the 2007 schedule. Note the miles reported on this spreadsheet will differ from the MPSCUrbanRuralYearend06, due to manner in which the miles are accounted. For example, a feeder 100 miles long started in Oct.2006, with 90 miles completed on December 31, 2006 and the additional 10 miles completed on January 20^{th,} 2007 would be accounted for in the following manner. Performance Management would show credit for 90 miles in 2006 and 10 miles in 2007. Under the feeder file, all the miles (100) would show in 2007 with the completion date.
