#### APPLICATION

Comes now Unite Private Networks, LLC, (hereinafter "Applicant"), a Missouri limited liability corporation, and pursuant to § 392.410 RSMo 2003, § 392.420-.450 RSMo 2000, § 392.361 RSMo 2000, 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) and (4), and 4 CSR 240-3.510 files this verified application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Commission") issue an order that grants to Applicant certificates of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services throughout Missouri, to provide non-basic local or unswitched telecommunications service throughout Missouri, and to provide basic local telecommunications services as a CLEC in the Missouri service areas of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Century Tel of Missouri, Spectra Communications, and Sprint Missouri, Inc.

In support of these Applications, Applicant states as follows:

1. Applicant is a Missouri limited liability corporation with its principal office and place of business at 303 N. Jefferson, Kearney, MO 64060. Applicant is authorized to do business in the State of Missouri. Attached hereto, marked Appendix A

and incorporated herein by reference is a Certificate of Good Standing from the Missouri Secretary of State.

- 3. Applicant is engaged in the provisioning of private network services in other states, and wishes to do so in Missouri. Applicant desires certificates of service authorities to provide interexchange service in Missouri, non-basic local or non-switched local service in Missouri, and basic local service within the service areas of ILECs that are not small rural ILECs. Applicant desires competitive classification of itself and its services.
- 4. Applicant requests a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange services in the state of Missouri.

- 5. Applicant requests a certificate of service authority to provide unswitched or non-basic local services in the state of Missouri.
- 6. Applicant requests a certificate of service authority to provide basic local services in the service areas of Southwestern Bell Telephone, CenturyTel of Missouri, Spectra Communications, and Sprint Missouri Inc.
- 7. Applicant requests the that it be granted Competitive Classification status pursuant to 392.361 RSMo, 392.420 RSMo, and 4 CSR 240-3.510 for purposes of the authority requested herein. The extent of competition, which exists in the local markets of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Century Tel of Missouri, Spectra Communications, and Sprint Missouri Inc. is such that a lesser degree of regulation of the services of Applicant is justified and in the public interest.
- 8. Pursuant to 392.361 RSMo, Applicant requests waiver of the following statutes and rules as a competitive alternative local exchange company:

9. Applicant will be providing interexchange and non-basic local services pursuant to tariffs. Applicant will be providing basic local services pursuant to tariffs. Applicant has not yet obtained an approved interconnection agreement upon which any basic local services must be structured. Applicant agrees that, once it is in a position to do so, it will submit to the Commission for approval tariffs which must become effective in order for Applicant to provide service under the certificates requested herein. Applicant requests a temporary waiver of the requirement of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1) that proposed tariffs accompany this Application.

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- 10. The character of the business anticipated to be performed by Applicant is to provide local and basic local services, and exchange access service, to customers within the state of Missouri, as a competitive alternative local exchange company, and as a provider of private networks systems and/or services.
- 11. Applicant has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three years of the date of this Application.
  - 12. Applicant has no annual report or assessment fees which are overdue.
- 13. Applicant states that, in accordance with 392.450, 392.451, and 392.455 RSMo, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), it will file and maintain tariffs with the Commission in the same manner and form as required of the ILECs with whom Applicant intends to compete, it will meet the minimum service standards required by the Commission of the ILECs with whom Applicant intends to compete, it will offer all Commission-determined essential local telecommunications services throughout the

service areas of any small ILECs with whom Applicant intends to compete, including two way switched voice service comprised of single line service including touch-tone dialing, access to local emergency services, access to basic local operator services, access to basic local directory assistance, standard intercept service, equal access to interexchange carriers, one standard white pages directory listing, and toll blocking or toll control for qualifying low-income customers, it will advertise the availability of such essential services and the charges therefore using media of general distribution, it will make such reports to and other information filings with the Commission as is required of ILECs with whom Applicant intends to compete, it will comply with the same rules and regulations the Commission imposes on ILECs with whom Applicant intends to compete, it will offer services in the geographic areas which will be no smaller than the exchange boundaries of the incumbent local exchange telecommunications company, that it will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service, and that it will provide equitable access to affordable telecommunications service for all Missourians regardless of where they live or their income, subject to the terms of the certificates, interconnection agreements, and tariffs that Applicant will be required to adhere to.

14. Applicant is in all respects fit, qualified, and capable of providing the services for which service authority is requested herein. Applicant possesses sufficient technical, managerial, and financial resources and abilities to provide the services for which service authority is requested herein, as demonstrated by its past operations as an alternative or competitive local exchange telecommunications company.

15. Granting of the Application is in the public interest in that it increases competition and increases the number of available LECs in portions of northern Missouri, as well as increasing the variety of telecommunications service available.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission grants it certificates of authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services throughout Missouri, to provide non-basic local or unswitched telecommunications service throughout Missouri, and to provide basic local telecommunications services as a CLEC in the Missouri service areas of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, Century Tel of Missouri, Spectra Communications, and Sprint Missouri, Inc., along with the competitive classifications, waivers, and other relief set forth above.


