5	complaint by the Staff of the Commission against Osage Water
6	Company.
7	Let's begin by taking entries of appearance,
8	starting on my left with Staff, Mr. Krueger.
9	MR. KRUEGER: Keith R. Krueger for the Staff
10	of the Missouri Public Service Commission. My address is

12	JUDGE MILLS: Thank you.
13	Mr. Mitchell?
14	MR. MITCHELL: My name is William P. Mitchell,
15	appearing for Osage Water Company, P.O. Box 650, Sunrise
16	Beach 60571.
17	JUDGE MILLS: Mr. Mitchell, what's your

- MR. MITCHELL: I'm the president.
- JUDGE MILLS: But you're not an attorney and
- 21 you don't have an attorney here on behalf of the company?
- MR. MITCHELL: No, sir. I'm strictly here to

- 22 out once and didn't get to anyone. The second time we sent
- 23 it out I believe it got to Osage Water Company and to Greg
- 24 Williams. Did you get a copy of the complaint the second
- 25 time it was sent out?
