At a Session of the Public Service Commission held at its office in Jefferson City on the 23rd day of March, 1994.

In the matter of St. Joseph Light and Power's allocation costs between electric, gas, and steam jurisdiction.

ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On August 13, 1993, the Commission established this docket for the purpose of considering issues related to the allocation of St. Joseph Light and Power Company's (St. Joseph) costs between its electric, gas, and steam jurisdictions. The Commission also directed that applications to intervene be filed on or before September 13, 1993.

An application to intervene was timely filed by AG Processing, Inc. (AGP). In support of its application, AGP states that it is a major industrial steam customer of St. Joseph and it has an ongoing interest in St. Joseph's rates.

Upon review of AGP's application and Commission regulations, the Commission finds that AGP has an interest in this matter which is different from that of the general public. Thus, the Commission determines that AGP should be permitted to intervene as a party in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That AG Processing, Inc. is hereby granted intervention in this case.
- 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
