ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

On August 17, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Shared Communications Services, Inc. Staff states that the Commission granted the company a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunication service in December 1997, in Case No. TA-98-186.

In support of its motion, Staff states that the company has requested, by letter, that its certificate be canceled. A copy of the letter is attached to Staff's motion. In its letter, the company indicated that it has no employees, assets, customers or revenue in Missouri. Staff states that the company owes no assessments or annual reports and recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate and accompanying tariff.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, provides that "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected." The Commission finds that canceling the certificate of service authority of Shared Communications is not detrimental to the public interest and will therefore cancel the certificate and accompanying tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to Shared Communications Services, Inc., is granted.

2. That the certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service granted to Shared Communications Services, Inc., in Case No. TA-98-186 is canceled.

3. That Shared Communications Services, Inc.'s tariff, P.S.C. MO. NO. 1, is canceled.

4. That this order shall become effective on September 12, 2005.

5. That this case may be closed on September 13, 2005.
