STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

- 1. On November 16, 2005, Call Processing, Inc. (CPI) filed its Application for the Cancellation of its Certificate of Service Authority (Application) in the above-captioned case. In accord with its Application, the Staff submits its Memorandum, attached hereto as Appendix A and incorporated by reference herein, recommending the cancellation of CPI's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff, P.S.C. Mo. Tariff No. 1, to provide interexchange telecommunications service.
- 2. CPI was granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service on October 23, 2000 in Case No. TA-2001-200. CPI's tariff, PSC MO No. 1, was approved in the same case. CPI states in its Application that it has no customers in Missouri. Therefore, cancellation of CPI's certificate of service authority is not detrimental to the public interest. CPI has no other matters pending before the Commission.
- 3. Because cancellation of CPI's certificate is not detrimental to public interest, CPI's certificate should be canceled by the Commission.
- 4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410, RSMo 2000 which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon Request of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order canceling the certificate of service authority of Call Processing, Inc. to provide interexchange telecommunications service and its accompanying P.S.C. MO Tariff No. 1.
