STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation, states as follows:

1. On July 16, 2010, CIMCO Communications, Inc. filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel its certificate of service authority. CIMCO was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services on November 7, 1997 in File No. TA-98-128.

2. On November 12, 2009, the Commission approved a transfer of all of CIMCO's Missouri customers to Comcast Phone of Missouri, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone, in File No. TO-2010-0117. On March 16, 2010, that transfer took place. At that time, CIMCO stopped using the name "CIMCO," but as it was no longer serving Missouri customers, the fact is irrelevant to this cancellation.

3. Because CIMCO requested cancellation of its certificate and it is not providing services in Missouri, Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate.

4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the Certificate of Service Authority for CIMCO Communications, Inc.
